

As (new) owner of Park Atlantis, what is interesting to know?

We would like to welcome you in our Park, wishing you a lot of fun during your holidays! We hope that the following information will help you and the other residents of the park. For more detailed information please visit our website www.parkatlantis.today.

- 1. Whom to turn to in case of questions?
 - The syndic, Axius, is the central contact point in case of general problems and questions about the park and the residences. Call 078/15.89.90 and ask for Sofie VERMANDERE. Preferably you can reach him via e-mail syndic@axius.be. Office: Bredeweg 10, 8420 De Haan (opening hours look www.axius.be)
 - The board members of your residence will also try to solve problems in the park, if possible. You can find their data in the info box in your residence or on our website www.parkatlantis.today.
- 2. Map of the park: look on the reverse side.
- 3. Where to dispose your waste?
 - Waste chalet: yellow refuse bags (for garbage), blue refuse bags (for plastic, cans and beverage cartons) and paper/cardboard (in boxes or tied together). The yellow and blue refuse bags can be bought in the local stores of Vosseslag.
 - The dog poo tubes in the park are strictly meant for dog waste bags.
 - Take the glass to the glass container. These are located in the vicinity of Dahlia on the one hand and ALHO (Acacia-Lotus-Hyacint-Orchidee) on the other hand. There is also a public glass container in Violierenlaan near Iris
 - Bulky waste or discarded furniture needs to be taken to the container park in De Haan (Duinenweg 32). The container park is open from Tuesday till Friday from 10 am till 11u45 am and from 13pm till 17pm. You have to buy an access card for €4 once at your town hall (dienst Ontvangst, Leopoldlaan 24).
- 4. Parking facilities? There are unlimited and free parking possibilities on the indicated spots in the park (see map). Parking in the loading and unloading areas is restricted to 15 minutes.
- 5. Noise and nuisances rules: Noise between 10pm and 8. Noise between 10pm and 8 am should be avoided. Also avoid construction works in July and August, during the school holidays. Do not drop ashes of cigarettes on the terraces below your own apartment. Do not feed the seagulls or other animals in the park. Dogs should always be kept on leash in the park.
- 6. Sport and recreation in the park? There is not only a playground in the park but also lots of sports facilities such as tennis, basket, football, petanque, jogging and walking. Please note that dogs, skating and playing football are not allowed on the tennis courts.
- 7. Emergency? Call 112 or 100 for an ambulance, an emergency doctor or the fire brigade. Call 101 for the police. There's a pharmacy in Vosseslag: Kennedyplein 106A. There are also a few family doctors available in Vosseslag: Heidelaan 47 on-call service: 059/23 90 99.
- 8. Getting to know Vosseslag? Check the map at the entrance.
 - There is a safe way to the beach: through the small gate at the parking space in front of the building Iris to the Violierenlaan. At the end of the street you go right into the Driftweg and then you take the first left where you cross the pedestrian bridge.
 - In Vosseslag you can find a few restaurants, a bakery, a grocery shop and several others. A supermarket, a butcher, a bank and a bike rental are located in De Haan and Bredene..
 - The tourist information office in Vosseslag (Kennedyplein) will provide you with further information. The office is open in July/August and during the weekends of Ascension and Pentecost. There is also a tourist information office at the tram station in De Haan which is open everyday.
